DAY 01 KUALA LUMPUR - SHARJAH - ISTANBUL

Gather at KLIA to board the direct flight to Istanbul. Overnight in Istanbul.

DAY 02 ISTANBUL - ANKARA

B/L/D

Sightseeing in Istanbul:

- Topkapi Palace (First Courtyard): The palace area of the sultan's residence The Ottoman Empire facing the Sea of Marmara was completed on year 1465 during the reign of Sultan Muhammad Al Fatih.
- Hagia Sofia Grand Mosque: Is a church in the 5th century before being converted into a mosque after the conquest of Constantinople. Became a museum during Ataturk's time and is now converted into a mosque again.
- Hippodrome: An area that used to be a racetrack horse in Byzantine times.
- Blue Mosque: Is an icon of the city of Istanbul built in 1616 with 6 towers and 5 large domes.
- Shopping for leather goods at the Leather Shop Outlet because of Turkey known as one of the leading countries in leather production.
- Shopping at the Grand Bazaar which is one of the markets that The largest and oldest in the world was built starting in 1455 a total of over 4,000 stores.

DAY 03 ANKARA - MT. ERCIYES - CAPPADOCIA

Sightseeing in Ankara:

- Mosaleum Ataturk: A complex built to showcase history struggle, personal belongings and funeral of Mustafa Kemal Ataturk.
- Haci Bayram Square: The famous square in Ankara where Haci Bayram Mosque is located and next to it the relics Roman ruins, Temple of Augustus.
- Depart to Mt. Erciyes to visit Mt. Erciyes Ski Resort (including cable car ticket) for free time to play in the snow or try to learn how to ski

DAY 04 CAPPADOCIA

- Underground City: Feel the unique experience of entering an underground city where at one time 15,000 people lived in the lower city this land to avoid enemy attacks.
- Uchisar Castle: See the uniqueness of The Flintstones-style stone house became a settlement and defense city of the people here since from 12th century.
- Goreme, Pigeon and Devrent Valleys: Enjoy the scenery The panorama of the rocky mountain valley is very beautiful here with unique rock formations.

Overnight in Cappadocia.

Tours in Cappadocia:

- Visit a pottery factory at Avanos Pottery & Art Center and also a gallery of Turquoise & Onyx gemstone processing Handmade Store.
- See the traditional way of making Turkish carpets that has been passed down since thousands of years ago at the Carpet Factory.

DAY 05 CAPPADOCIA - KONYA - PAMUKKALE

- Ancient Caravanserai: Formerly a hotel for merchants who passed through the Silk Road and is over 700 years old.

Sightseeing in Konya:

- Mevlana Museum: Learn the history of the development of Islam in Turkey by the Sunni Sufi group who are famous for the Whirling Dervish religious ceremony and also a collection of Ottoman Sultan items.

DAY 06 PAMUKKALE - BURSA

Tours in Pamukkale:

- Ancient Hierapolis City: The old city of the Greek era from the beginning 2nd century again. Among the buildings that are still intact is Frontinus Gate, The Great Baths, Theatre, Temple of Apollo and Cleopatra's Pool at where the hot pool water is still natural to this day.
- Cotton Castle: The hot water pool terraces are white cotton is formed naturally on the slopes of this mountain and participants can soak your feet in this hot water pool.
- Shopping at the Cotton Textile Factory Outlet.

DAY 07 BURSA - ISTANBUL

Visit in Bursa:

- Shopping for traditional Turkish food and ingredients in Turkish Delight & Oil Shop.
- Ulu Camii Mosque: The mosque is over 600 years old which is quite historic during the Ottoman period was built in 1399.
- Koza Han: An old market famous for trading goods silk cloth since 1491 until today.
- Green Mosque: A mosque built in 1412 by Atuk Sultan Mehmed I Celebi after his successful unification of the empire Ottoman.
- Green Tomb: Tomb of Sultan Mehmed I Celebi who was the 5th Sultan
- Visiting Cumalilizik Village which is a village from the past Ottoman which started around 1300 during the formation Ottoman Empire.

Sightseeing in Istanbul:

- Grand Camlica Mosque: The largest mosque in Turkey that was completed in year 2019 can accommodate up to 63,000 pilgrims at one time.
- Shopping for leather goods at the Leather Shop Outlet because Turkey is known as one of the leading countries in leather production
- Shopping at the Grand Bazaar which is one of the largest markets and the oldest was built since 1455 with a total of over 4,000 shops.

DAY 08 ISTANBUL - SHARJAH

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Return to Kuala Lumpur by flight, transit in Sharjah.

Sightseeing in Istanbul:

- Board a private Bosphorus Cruise Tour along the Bosphorus Strait and see some historical attractions along the banks of Europe and Asia such as Rumelihisari which is the main defensive city built since 1452 when Sultan Al Fatih was conquering Constantinople, Anadoluhisari which is the first defensive city in this sea built in 1393, the Ottoman administration office and the modern Turkish Dolmabahce Palace which was built in 1856 by the 31st Ottoman Sultan and Ortakoy Mosque which is the most famous mosque in the Bosphorus Strait built since 1854.
