ISTANBUL

DAY 02 ISTANBUL -
ANKARA

- Topkapi Palace (First Courtyard): Palace of residence of the imperial sultanate The Ottomans overlooking the Sea of Marmara were completed in 1465 during the reign of Sultan Muhammad Al Fatih.
 - Hagia So a Grand Mosque: Is a church in the 5th century before being converted into a mosque after the conquest of Constantinople. Became a museum during Ataturk's time and is now converted into a mosque again.
 - Hippodrome: An area that used to be a chariot racing arena in Byzantine times.
 - Blue Mosque: Is an icon of the city of Istanbul built in 1616 with 6 towers and 5 large domes.
- Overnight in Ankara.

DAY 03 ANKARA - MT. ERCIYES
-CAPPADOCIA

Visits in **Ankara:**

- Mosaleum Ataturk: A complex built to showcase history struggle, personal belongings and funeral of Mustafa Kemal Ataturk.
 - Haci Bayram Square: The famous square in Ankara where it is located Haci Bayram Mosque and next to it the ruins of the Roman era, Temple of Augustus.
 - Depart to Mt. Erciyes to visit Mt. Erciyes Ski Resort (incl cable car ticket) for free time to play in the snow or try to study how to ski
- Overnight in **Cappadocia.**

Visits in **Cappadocia:**

- Goreme, Pigeon and Devrent Valleys: Enjoy the panoramic views a very beautiful rocky mountain valley here with unique rock formations.
 - Underground City: Feel the unique experience of entering an underground city where once upon a time 15,000 people lived in this underground city to avoid enemy attacks.
 - Uchisar Castle: See the uniqueness of The Flintstones-style stone houses that have been a settlement and a defensive city for the people here since the 12th century.
 - Visit a pottery factory at Avanos Pottery & Art Center and the Turquoise & Onyx Handmade Store gemstone processing gallery.
 - See the traditional way of making Turkish carpets that has been passed down thousands of years ago at the Carpet Factory.
- Overnight in **Cappadocia.**

DAY 05 CAPPADOCIA -
KONYA - PAMUKKALE

- Ancient Caravanserai: Formerly a hotel for merchants who passed through the Silk Road and is over 700 years old.

Visits in **Konya:**

- Mevlana Museum: Learn the history of the development of Islam in Turkey by the Sunni group famous for the Whirling Dervish religious ceremony and also a collection of Ottoman Sultan items.

Overnight in **Pamukkale.**

DAY 06 PAMUKKALE -
BURSA

Tours in Pamukkale:

- Ancient Hierapolis City: An old city left over from the Greek era since the beginning of the 2nd century. Among the buildings that are still intact are Frontinus Gate, The Great Baths, Theatre, Temple of Apollo and Cleopatra's Pool where the hot pool water is still natural to this day.
- Cotton Castle: White cotton-like hot water pool terraces are formed naturally on the mountainside and participants can soak their feet in this hot water pool.
- Shopping at the Cotton Textile Factory Outlet.

ISTANBUL

Visit in Bursa:

- Shop for traditional Turkish food and ingredients at Turkish Delight & Oil Shop.
- Ulu Camii Mosque: A mosque that is over 600 years old and quite historic during the Ottoman period was built in 1399.
- Koza Han: An old market famous for the trade of silk cloth goods since 1491 until today.
- Green Mosque: A mosque built in 1412 by Sultan Mehmed I's grandfather Celebi after his success united the Ottoman empire.
- Green Tomb: The tomb of Sultan Mehmed I Celebi who was the 5th Sultan of the Ottoman Empire was built in 1421.
- Visiting Cumalilizik Village which is a village from the Ottoman era that started around the year 1300 during the formation of the Ottoman Empire.

Sightseeing in Istanbul:

- Shopping for leather goods at the Leather Shop Outlet as Turkey is famous for as one of the leading countries in leather production.
- Shopping at the Grand Bazaar which is one of the largest and oldest markets in the world was built back in 1455 with a total of over 4,000 shops.

HARI 08 ISTANBUL

- Bosphorus Cruise: Cruise the Bosphorus Strait and see some historic attractions along the banks of Europe and Asia such as Rumelihisari which is the main defensive city built since 1452 when Sultan Al Fatih was conquering Constantinople, Anadoluhisari which is the first defensive city on the sea built in 1393, the Ottoman administration office and the modern Turkish Dolmabahce Palace which was built in 1856 by the 31st Ottoman sultan and Ortakoy Mosque which is the most famous mosque in The Bosphorus Strait was built in 1854.
 - Spice Bazaar: The main focus is to buy different types of spices and traditional Turkish food such as Turkish Delight since 1660.
- Depart to the airport for the flight to Kuala Lumpur
