Tours in Madrid:

- Take photos at Plaza de Espana and the Royal Palace.
 - Gran Vía: This main street in Madrid, nicknamed "Spanish Broadway," is also one of the most important shopping areas in the city of Madrid.
 - Cibeles Fountain: The sculpture and architecture of the fountain located in the middle of the Plaza de Cibeles has become one of the icons in the center of Madrid.
 - Neptune Fountain: A fountain located in the center of Madrid that represents Neptune, the Roman god of water.
 - Free time to stroll and shop at Puerta del Sol and Plaza Mayor, which are close to the official palace of the Spanish monarch.
 - Visit Las Ventas BullRing, the largest bullring in Spain with a seating capacity of 23,798 making it the third largest bullring in the world.
 - Take photos at Santiago Bernabeu Stadium which is the home of the iconic Real Madrid football team for photos.
 - Pray at the Madrid Central Mosque.
 - Free time to shop for designer goods such as Armani, Coach, Ralph Lauren which offer discounts of up to 60% at Las Rozas Village Outlet.
- Overnight in Madrid.

MERIDA - LISBON

Tours in Toledo:

- Puerta de Bisagra: Toledo city gate built in the 10th century on the eve of Toledo's Moorish Taifa in Islamic Al-Andalus.
- Visit Mirador del Valle to stop for a photo, which is the best spot to take pictures with the beautiful view of Toledo.
- Mosque of Cristo de la Luz: A historic mosque built in 999 during Moorish rule before being converted into a church.
- Alcántara Bridge: A bridge built by the Romans in the Middle Ages across the Tanguis River.
- Free time at Plaza de Zocodover, Toledo's main square and ancient Arab market. On this "Street of Commerce" there are several cafes and buildings above, most of which are offices, for souvenir shopping or wandering around.

Tours in Merida:

- Temple of Diana: An ancient Roman building that still stands strong today with 18 tall columns surrounding this temple.
- Porch of The Forum: This is a Roman forum area built in the first century and the forum columns are still standing.
- The Alcazaba: Originally the first Moorish fortified city in Spain, built by Abd ar-Rahman II in 855.
- Arch of Trajan: A 15m high gate built during the ancient Roman period.

Tours in Lisbon:

- Jeronimos Monastery: A very beautiful large monastery with stunning architecture.
- Belem Tower: A monument built as the entrance to the City of Lisbon and as a defense against any threats and invasions.
- Monument of the Discoveries: A memorial built to commemorate the first ship to sail to the Indian Ocean.

- Pray at the Central Mosque of Lisbon which is the third largest mosque in Europe built in 1985.

- Free time for sightseeing and shopping at Rossio Square, Praca do Comercio and Freeport Fashion Outlet.

- Plaza de Espana: Located within the Maria Luisa Park area and has a large fountain in the middle as well as paintings along the walls that tell the history of Spain's glory and were once the filming location for the Star Wars film.

- Royal Alcazar of Seville: Built during the Islamic period in the 10th century and served as the center of government of the Islamic kingdom of Seville until 1248 after the kingdom of Castile conquered Seville.

- Torre del Oro: A 36m high watchtower located on the banks of the river in the center of Seville, built in 1220 by the Almohad Islamic government.

- Giralda Tower: Originally the tower of the great mosque of Seville during the Islamic period, but most of the mosque was destroyed and only this tower survived.

Tours in Cordoba:

- Mosque of Cordoba: The largest mosque in Europe was converted into a church after the fall of the Islamic empire. The carvings of the Quran on the walls of the mosque, pillars, minaret and mihrab can still be seen.
- Roman Bridge: This stunning Roman bridge in the city was built in the first century and spans the Guadalquivir River for 331m.
- Calahorra Tower: A tower built during the reign of the Almohad Islamic kingdom to control the entrances and exits of the city of Cordoba.

Tours in Granada:

- Alhambra Palace: A major landmark in Granada and a testament to the greatness of Islamic rule in Spain hundreds of years ago. Originally built in the 9th century as a fortress, it was converted into a palace in the 11th century.
- The Generalife: A summer retreat palace built in the 13th century by the Nasrid royal family with pools, patios and flower gardens.
- Albayzin Muslim Quarters: The oldest area that has preserved much of its Islamic architecture since the 11th century. Among the things that can still be seen are the city walls, the Puerta Monaita gate, the Almohad tower which is part of the San Juan church and also houses built in the 14th century.
- Grand Mosque of Granada: Completed in 2003, this mosque offers the most attractive location to take panoramic photos of the Alhambra Palace which is located on the other side of the hill of this mosque.
- Take a ferry from Tarifa across the Strait of Gibraltar to Tangier.

Tours in Rabat:

- Kasbah of the Udayas: This city built in the 11th century houses an Andalusian-era palace, administration and garden complex, a major attraction that offers panoramic views of the Atlantic Ocean.
- Hassan Tower: This tower was one of the largest mosques in the world but was demolished in 115 Marrakesh after the death of the king, al-Mansur in 1199.
- Mausoleum of Mohamed V: The tomb of the king of Morocco, built in 1971 with a design that follows traditional Moroccan architecture.
- Royal Palace: The official palace of the Moroccan king, built since 1864, is known as Dar Al-Makhzen and has a golden gate.

DAY 09 | RABAT - MARRAKESH

Tours in Marrakesh:

- Jemaa el-Fnaa: A square that features various traditional attractions of this country that are very unusual, especially the night market where there are various stalls selling various types of food, street performances, acrobatic shows and there is also a bazaar area (called Medina) that sells robes, headscarves and spices.
 - Bahia Palace: The palace is the residence of the city's ruler and was built in 1900 with beautiful carvings, ornaments and decorations, and a beautiful courtyard.
 - Koutoubia Mosque: This historic mosque was built in 1158 with a 77m high minaret and its construction was the inspiration for the Giralda Tower in Seville and the Hassan Tower in Rabat.
- Overnight in Marrakesh.

DAY 10 | MARRAKESH - CASABLANCA - ISTANBUL

Tours in Casablanca:

- Hassan II Mosque: The 7th largest mosque in the world, capable of accommodating 105,000 worshippers, with its 210m minaret the 2nd tallest in the world. It was built in 1993 under the guidance of King Hassan II
- Depart for the airport to return to Kuala Lumpur (transit in Istanbul).

1. ALHAMBRA PALACE
